



Research and strategic reviews into education issues and trends

Ruskin Education provides educational research and strategic support for several organisations across the region. Commissioned by the British Council to research current provision for university undergraduates in the UAE to identify possible opportunities for supporting pre-university English and study skills, the research reviewed current strategy in the UAE and possible links to British Council offerings that would meet local needs and help the government meet its target for the reduction of pre-prep programmes for students seeking university higher education courses.

Appointed by the International Labour Organisation (ILO), Ruskin Education was commissioned to undertake research into labour trends for the employment of South Asian workers in Kuwait. A mixture of desk based research and face to face interviews with employers and government agencies provided the breadth of evidence upon which to provide a report to help steer future labour market strategy.

Our research team has been employed by several financial investors to undertake feasibility studies for several sites and acquisitions linked with the opening of new schools and nurseries in the MENA region and seeking information on the siting and commercial viability of particular propositions.

Our team of researchers and consultants provided the core structure of each project and, through a combination of desk research, focus group discussions and interviews with key individual and strategic bodies, have drawn together data, evidence and information to inform and construct high level reports for our clients. In several cases, these projects have led to follow up activity on behalf of clients.
